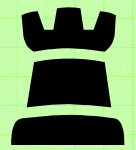
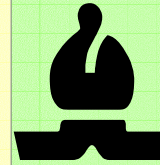


Wintergreen Interdistrict Magnet Chess Program

Why should students play Chess?

Intermediate Level Program: Opening Principles, Space, Time, Positional Play, Tactics and Combinations, Strategy, How to Analyze a Position, Opening Repertoire.

About the instructors: Instructors are assistant coaches of the West Haven High School State and New England Championship team. The Program will be guided by a USCF Certified Chess Coach and Tournament Director, Jim Celone, Yale BA '83, MS '01. At West Haven High School, Mr. Celone teaches math and chess, coaches their 10-time state championship, and 2005 New England Championship Renegade Knights chess team and runs fifteen local elementary school chess programs in the Greater New Haven area. He was honored as 2002 CT Chess Coach of the Year.
